APPLICATION FOR EXECUTIVE CLEMENCY

Under K.S.A. 22-3701, the Kansas Parole Board is responsible for processing and reviewing applications for Executive Clemency. The law requires that the sentencing court and prosecuting attorney be notified of the application, and that a notice be published in the official county paper. The Kansas Parole Board then reviews pertinent records, reports, and other available information. If a personal interview with the applicant is needed, the applicant will be notified. Following review, the **Kansas Parole Board** submits its report to the **Governor**, who makes the final decision in all clemency matters. Applicants must supply the information requested below.
